

#### **Commitment to Learning criteria**


+3	An enthusiastic, determined, and resilient learner. Completes extension tasks and additional work.
+2	Shows determination and resilience. Completes all independent learning thoroughly.
+1	Expectations for learning are exceeded. Shows independence in learning.
0	Minimum expectations met. Completes tasks adequately and meets independent learning deadlines.
-1	Often not working at potential. Inadequate effort in class or independent work limits progress.
-2	Low motivation or poor focus. Insufficient effort. Can be disruptive.




### WPA Post 16 Destinations 2023
