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Dear Year 11 Family,

It was lovely to see so many of our Year 11 students back at WPA for their Prom last Friday- thanks to Mrs Burgess and the Prom Committee for putting together such a fitting end to their time with us!

Although there is a long, enjoyable summer ahead for our Year 11s, we wanted to take the opportunity to alert you to the arrangements for collecting GCSE results in August, which we shared in our recent leavers' assembly.

- GCSE results day takes place on Thursday August 20th, with students collecting their results between 9.00am-10.00am from WPA- the collection point will be signposted on arrival at the front gates.
- Any student who wishes to have a family member collect results on their behalf, or receive their results via email (this would be later in the day on August 20th) needs to request this in writing by emailing our examinations office at examsofficer@wellandparkacademy.com. We will not be able to release results to family members or by email without this.
- If you arrive after 10.00am the results will be available for collection at main reception.
- Attached to this email are forms relating to the Post Results Service- these are for candidates who believe an error has been made in the grading of their GCSE, and we will support you with this process where appropriate following results day.

From approximately 11am, students will be able to access their GCSE results in their "Education Record" app, which they can then take to share with their post-16 providers.

We very much look forward to celebrating our students' results with them and will also be on hand to support with any post-16 advice and communication that may be required.

With many of our students holding multiple post-16 offers, decisions will need to be made following results day regarding the right choice for them. Attached are the most recently available DfE published post-16 results for the providers that the majority of our students apply to. This is just one piece of publicly available information that should be considered alongside information relating to individual course choices such as the course content and structure, information gleaned from open day visits and communications with each establishment in making a well-informed choice.
